PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Applicability of Permit

- a) This Permit applies only to the vehicle listed in Part I Application of this Permit.
- b) The Permit Holder owns the vehicle listed in Part I of this Permit.

2. Maximum Permit Weight

- a) The maximum manufacturer's rating for the front axle weight of the vehicle described in Part I Application of this Permit is _____ kg.
- b) The maximum front axle weight authorized by this permit shall not exceed the manufacturer's rating for the front steering axle of the vehicle.
- c) The vehicle listed in Part I Application of this permit must be equipped with front axle tires with a manufacturer's rating that meets or exceeds the manufacturer's rating for the front steering axle as described in 2(a) of this Permit.
- d) Tire loads cannot exceed tire specifications.

3. Vehicle Inspection/safety, insurance and registration requirements

The permit holder shall at all times:

- a) Maintain a valid Periodic Motor Vehicle Inspection (PMVI) decal for the vehicle listed in Part I Application and display a PMVI decal on the vehicle.
- b) Maintain a valid Periodic Motor Vehicle Inspection (PMVI) decal for each trailer used in combination with the vehicle described in Part I Application, and display that decal on each trailer.
- c) Maintain valid registration for the tractor and trailer(s) operated under this Permit.
- d) Maintain insurance coverage for the vehicle that meets or exceeds the minimum established under the Yukon Motor Vehicles Act.

4. Suspension of the Permit

The permit will be suspended, and the permit holder notified in writing of the suspension, when it is demonstrated that the permit holder is in non-compliance with:

- a) Requirements relating to vehicle inspection/safety, or insurance or registration as set out in this permit.
- b) Front axle weight established by this permit on more than two occasions in a three-month period.

PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5. Reinstatement of Permit

The permit may be reinstated once the permit holder can demonstrate that the:

- a) Vehicle inspection/safety, insurance and registration requirements in Section 2 of this Permit have been met and
- b) The vehicle has reported to a Yukon government weigh station on every trip for weight monitoring and has been found to be operating within the permitted front axle overload weight for ten (10) consecutive trips.

6. Offense to operate at weights in excess of the front axle overload weight limits established by this permit.

- a) It is an offense to operate a vehicle under this permit with a front axle weight that exceeds the maximum front axle overload weight authorized by this Permit.
- b) A fine may be assessed under the Summary Conviction Regulations for this offense.

7. Cancellation of the Permit

The Minister may cancel this permit for repeated suspensions of the permit for non-compliance with permit conditions.

8. Changes to the Front Axle

When the front axle of a vehicle is replaced or modified the Permit Holder shall:

- a) Immediately notify the Manager, Carrier Compliance, Transport Services Branch in writing, providing details of the modified or replacement axle, as well as the new manufacturer's rating for the axle.
- b) If the new manufacturer's rating for the front steering axle does not meet the rating authorized by this Permit, and the Permit Holder wishes to be provided with a Front Axle Overload Permit, the Permit Holder must complete a new application for this permit, and must meet the permit criteria.

9. Sale of a vehicle or permanent removal from the Road

- a) When the vehicle is sold or permanently removed from the road, the Permit Holder shall immediately notify the Manager, Carrier Compliance Branch.
- b) The Permit is not transferable.

PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

10. Expiry of the Permit

Unless suspended or cancelled, this permit is valid for the life of the vehicle or until the front axle of a vehicle is replaced, or modified.
