

# Renewing your Yukon Driver's Licence (DL)/ General Identification Card (GIC)

Please visit our Whitehorse office or any one of our 10 satellite offices throughout Yukon. You will need to present your expired or expiring Yukon DL/GIC and any one (1) of the following current documents reflecting your address:

- Utility bill such as; ATCO Electric, NorthwTel (telephone and/or internet), municipal utilities bills (water and sewer/property taxes)
- Bank statement or a stamped banking profile from a local bank, credit card statement
- Mortgage documentation
- Income tax return (notice of assessment) recent year
- Signed residential tenancy agreement

- Social assistance benefit confirmation
- Employment confirmation (signed and on company letterhead)

Once renewed, you will receive a 90-day temporary DL. There are no temporary GIC's. Your permanent DL or GIC will be mailed to you within 5 – 10 business days.

- \* If you are travelling within 10 days, and provide proof of your travel, a secure Yukon DL/GIC may be produced immediately.

**NOTE:** Yukon Health Care cards and cellphone bills cannot be used as proof of Yukon residency. You can renew your DL/GIC 6 months before expiry.
